Charter of Incorporation

Be It Known, That David B. Collins, T. Elder, Tom Henry F. Arnold, Jr., Marvin E. Goodstein, Frank R. Murray

are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name of and style of

THE SEWANEE CIVIC ASSOCIATION, Sewanee, Tennessee

for the purpose of

- 1. The maintenance of a club for social enjoyment;
2. To encourage and promote among the members closer personal acquaintance and a friendly spirit of mutual cooperation;
3. To promote and encourage the development of the general welfare and civic betterment of the community of Sewanee; to assist in the maintenance of the public school and school buildings, and upon proper authorization to act as the agent or delegate in the management and support of the same; to take all lawful steps for the promotion of the public health, the maintenance of public order, including police protection and contributing to the support of the same; to assist in reducing fire hazards and to secure adequate fire protection; to carry out such other common community tasks as it may lawfully undertake.

Expulsion shall be the only remedy for the nonpayment of dues by the members, and there shall be no individual liability against the members for corporate debts, but the entire corporate property shall be liable for the claims of creditors.

We, the undersigned, the incorporators above mentioned, hereby apply to the State of Tennessee for a charter of incorporation for the purposes declared in the foregoing instrument.
